This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.83 dated 27.05.2019, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 of the IPC, Section 25, 54 and 59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Kamboj, Amritsar.

[2]. Ld. Counsel for both sides are ad idem that compromise has already been effected between the parties on account of which the complainant does not oppose the bail prayer of the petitioner.

[3]. Considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner till now since 13.03.2020, which is the tune of 10 months and 13 days, at this stage, as also the fact that the trial is likely to take its own substantial time, particularly on account of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, the prayer of the
