Petitioners herein *inter alia* seek issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release their LTC for the block year 2016-2019 along with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that qua their aforesaid grievance, petitioners also caused issuance of a legal notice dated 16.05.2021 (Annexure P-11) but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the instant petition.

3. On advance service, learned State counsel appears and opposes the issuance of notice of motion. She submits that competent authority shall take decision either way, on the pending legal notice dated 16.05.2021 (Annexure P-11) in due course.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners also agrees that let a final decision be taken, by the competent authority on the pending legal notice dated 16.05.2021 (Annexure P-11).

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioners as per legal notice dated 16.05.2021 (Annexure P-11) and also by keeping in view the contentions raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law. Let the needful be done as expeditiously as possible.

7. Disposed of accordingly.
