Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail', upon FIR No. 0140 having been registered at Police Station Guru Harsahai, District Ferozepur, on 17.08.2021, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 307/458/323/427/148/149 of the ,.IPC.

As per the status report taken on record on the last date of hearing (a copy of which has been given by learned State counsel again in court today, it actually not being on the case file), the complainant, other injuries apart, suffered a fracture of his left parietal and frontal bone.

Though learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the said injury is not attributed to either of the petitioners, however, it is seen that as per the FIR the petitioners were also found to be armed with an 'iron rod' and

a '*Punch*' and are actually alleged to have inflicted some injuries on the complainant along with their co-accused, i.e. a total of 10 persons.

In view of the above, I see absolutely no ground to entertain this petition, which is consequently dismissed.

[It is to be noticed that in the order dated 22.11.2021, it has erroneously stated that the interim order would continue, with there actually being no interim order passed in favour of the petitioners.]
