The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.577 dated 26.09.2020 under Sections 323, 498A, 406, 506 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sirsa City, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would contend that during the pendency of this petition vide order dated 24.11.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, apart from paying an amount of Rs. 15, 000/- to the complainant as litigation expenses. It is contended that the matter stands compromised before the Mediation and Conciliation Center, and a settlement agreement dated 15.01.2021 has been prepared the same is placed on record. It is further contended that as per the order dated 24.11.2020 the petitioner has already joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and the matter has been investigated.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused the interim order dated 24.11.2020. The matter has been settled amicably between the parties and as per the settlement agreement, the parties have decided to resolve the dispute between them and to continue their matrimonial ties as husband and wife alongwith a minor child. The matter has been investigated and petitioner has joined the investigation. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 24.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
