Petitioner-Dildar Singh, stated to be aged approximately 28 years, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to quash the impugned order dated 30.04.2015 (Annexure P-4).

Today, CM-13196-CWP-2021, has been listed on behalf of the applicant-petitioner *inter alia* with a prayer for withdrawal of the present writ petition with the liberty to avail remedy before respondent No.2.

By making reference to pleadings of the application, learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner submits that he has instructions from the petitioner that he does not want to pursue the writ petition, therefore, he prays for withdrawal of the same.
