This is an application filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for placing on record the correct translated version of Annexure P-3.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed.

Correct translated version of Annexure P-3, is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.90 dated 14.05.2015 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for sometime and keeping in view the fact that in the present case, FIR is of the year 2015 and even the charges have been framed and one witness has been examined, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points as raised in the present petition during the course of trial before the trial Court. He further prays that the personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court in the present case be exempted as repeated appearances of the petitioner before the trial Court is causing serious prejudice to his work.

In view of the abovesaid, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid and the personal appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court is exempted, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) Petitioner shall be represented through his/her counsel;
- ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings;
- iii) shall not dispute his identity as accused;
- iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in his absence but in the presence of his/her counsel;
- v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court;
- vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
