Through this petition, the petitioner seek anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.222 dated 23.10.2020 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Sujampur, Tehsil and District Pathankot.

Vide order dated 24.11.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 24.11.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery has also been effected from him.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation. He further submits that the challan has been presented on 19.10.2021.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case,

the present petition is allowed and the order dated 24.11.2020 granting *ad-interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
