(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short, "the Cr.P.C.") for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.78 dated 15.03.2018 registered under Sections 500, 501, 354-D of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, "the IPC") and Section 67-A of the Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana to which Section 376 of the IPC and Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 were added lateron and from which Section 354-D of the IPC was deleted.

Reply by way of affidavit of Jashandeep Singh Gill, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (South), Ludhiana on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in the Registry of this Court which is taken on record.

Learned State Counsel has submitted that the prosecution evidence has been concluded in the case and even statement of the petitioner under Section 313 of the Cr.P.C. has been recorded and the case is fixed for defence evidence.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.

However, in view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial and dispose of the case expeditiously preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court concerned for requisite compliance.
