FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the retiral benefits including payment of gratuity, leave encashment and other arrears of salary and also employees provident fund and security along with interest @18% per annum of the petitioner on account of attaining the age of superannuation withheld illegally, arbitrarily and violating the principles of natural justice.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with

the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 24.06.2021 (Annexure P-8) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
