The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioners have come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for the issuance of direction to respondent-department to promote petitioners as Accountant Grade II w.e.f. 20.08.1993, Accountant Grade-I w.e.f. 14.12.2006 and Executive Officer Grade III w.e.f. 22.12.2011 notionally and further direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 to pass speaking order and decide the representations submitted by petitioner No. 1 dated 02.06.2021 (Annexure P-9) and by petitioner No. 2 dated 04.06.2021 (Annexure P-10).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the representations dated 02.06.2021 and 04.06.2021 (Anneuxre P-9 and Annexure P-10) of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay as per law.
