The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for revising the pension of the husband of the petitioner and family pension case of the petitioner after the death of her husband, for which, legal notice dated 21.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner

side, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 21.05.2021 (Annexure P-4) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
