This is a petition for return of jewellery and cash which was seized during the search operation on the ground that the petitioner has paid all the tax liability and nothing is due from her to the Income Tax.

Learned counsel states that in connection, the petitioner has made application on 15.01.2020 (Annexure P6) to respondent No.4 and also on 23.01.2020 (Annexure P-7), but no order has been passed thereon. He further states that he would be satisfied at this stage, if a direction is given to respondent No.4 to decide the said application by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three weeks. Consequently, we dispose of this writ petition directing respondent No.4 to decide the said application by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
