For the reasons mentioned in the application, copy of application seeking opinion of the doctor with regard to cause of death and report of pathology department of BPS Medical College Khanpur Kalan, Sonapat of deceased Gulshan Kumar son of Naresh Kumar, Annexures P-10 and P-11, are taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Application is accordingly disposed of.

Prayer in this application is for listing this matter, which was adjourned sine die on 25.09.2018, while directing that this writ be taken up after the cause of death is ascertained.

CWP No. 24576 of 2018.

Prayer in this writ petition is for grant of compensation to the petitioners on account of death of Gulshan Kumar, who is stated to have died due to electrocution caused by sheer negligence on the part of respondent no.3-UHBVNL .

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sharan Sethi, Addl.AG., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 and 2. Advance copy of writ petition stand supplied.

Mr. Ashish Yadav, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.3 to 5. Advance copy of writ petition stand supplied.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer for consideration of petitioners claim for compensation in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for the respondents do not raise any serious objection to the restricted prayer.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed with a direction to the competent authority to treat the present writ petition along with medical reports as a representation and decide the same within a period of three months from receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of a decision adverse to the petitioner, same be by

way of a speaking order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
