The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 226 dated 14.8.2020 registered under Section 8 of POCSO Act at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

FIR was registered on the statement of one Vandana Sharma, Centre Admin, Sakhi one stop Centre, Roopnagar. It is stated that on 11.8.2020 she and her minor son was in office. She had to leave office at about 5 pm as she has to deal with an urgent medical emergency care. The petitioner was present in office. She left her son in the charge of petitioner. When she came back, her son told that petitioner had tried to touch his private part. When he resisted, then petitioner let him go.

Petitioner is in custody since 14.8.2020. The investigation in this case is complete. The challan has been filed.

Without commenting anything on the merits of case and considering the fact that petitioner is in custody since 14.8.2020, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind bars any further. As such, petition is accepted. Petitioner Jagmohan Singh alias Jeeta is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
