This petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to provide protection to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No. 4 and 5.

A status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Madan Lal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala, District Ambala on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed wherein it is stated that statements of petitioners were recorded. Petitioner No. 1 Jyoti in her statement stated that she is residing happily in her matrimonial home and apprehends no threat to her life and liberty from private respondents. To the same effect is the statement of petitioner No. 2. Respondents No. 4 and 5 also telephonically informed ASI Balkar Singh that they have no objection to the marriage of petitioners.

This petition was listed for hearing on 23.12.2020 and 3.2.2021. However, none had appeared on behalf of petitioners. Today also, none has put in appearance on behalf of petitioners.

In view of status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Madan Lal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala, District Ambala wherein it is stated that statements of petitioners have been recorded to the effect that as of now, they apprehend no danger to their lives and liberty at the hands of private respondents, no further directions are required in this petition and same is disposed of.
