GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.0469 dated 17.10.2020 at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa, under Section 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act.
2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion, the following order was passed on 25.11.2020:

“The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case where 100 capsules of 'Paravorin Spas' (Tramadol) were allegedly recovered from Jasmail Singh, who during the course of interrogation is alleged to have suffered a disclosure statement to the effect that it is the petitioner who had supplied the same.

Notice of motion for 04.03.2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation

as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Learned State counsel upon instructions has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation and that he is not involved in any other case.
4. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation, the petition is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 25.11.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
