The present judgment shall dispose of 5 writ petitions bearing CWP-19997 & 21498-2020, CWP-4978, 5128 & 5130-2021, involving common questions of facts and law.

Counsel for the petitioners has fairly submitted that the petitioners, in the present set of cases, had not been appointed in the earlier selection of 2006 and therefore, the benefit of equity which had been granted in CWP-19895-2020 titled *Rajesh Kumar Vs. State of Haryana & others*, decided on 08.09.2021, is not liable to be granted to them. It is submitted that in the said case, persons who had scratched/smudged/double marked their answer-sheets, their petitions had been dismissed, keeping in view the settled principles of law by distinguishing it from the persons who had been appointed earlier.

Accordingly, keeping in view the observations made in Rajesh Kumar (supra), the present writ petitions are also dismissed.
