The present appeal has been preferred against the order dated 29.09.2021 passed by learned Single Judge in CM-14195-CWP-2021 in CWP-21203-2018.

We do not find any reason for interfering in the present appeal, however, learned counsel for the appellant has pointed out and referred to the earlier orders which have been passed wherein the applications for pre-ponement were accepted on 25.02.2020 and 09.07.2020. Counsel for the appellant asserts that on earlier occasions there was some affidavit which was filed by the respondent-State in pursuance to the order dated 23.02.2021 passed by the learned Single Judge in the writ petition which has been preferred by the appellant but the same was withdrawn and two dates have been sought for filing a fresh affidavit but till date neither such affidavit nor any reply to the application for stay has been filed.

Learned Counsel for the State is directed to ensure that reply to the writ petition as well as to the application for stay be filed within the period of 06 weeks from today failing which cost would be imposed by the Court.

We also direct to list CWP No.21203 of 2018 titled as 'Knight Detective and Security Services Pvt. Ltd. Vs. State of Haryana and another' on the date already fixed i.e. 17.12.2021.

The present appeal, therefore, stands disposed of with the above observations/directions.
