The petitioner-Jagjit Singh has come up in this 4th regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.68 dated 19.04.2017, under Sections 498-A, 420, 120-B IPC in which offences under Sections 419, 491, 494, 495, 465, 467, 468, 376, 506 IPC were added later on, registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

This Court vide detailed orders had earlier dismissed the similar bail applications of the petitioner on 08.10.2018; 18.03.2019 and 06.11.2020.

Even the assailment made by the petitioner before the

Apex Court did not meet with any success and where, too it met its nemesis. Keeping in view the reasons detailed in the earlier bail orders of this Court and the declining of his plea before the Apex Court, does not call for any interference at this juncture.

The petition stands dismissed accordingly.
