ANOOP CHITKARA, J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that FIR on the complaint of petitioner has been registered and some of accused persons have been arrested.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a threat perception to the petitioner at the hands of the private respondents.

Given above, the nature of order this Court proposes to pass' needs no adjudication on merits. Any officer authorised by SHO of the concerned Police Station shall visit the premises of the private respondents not to cause any intimidation, threat or duress to the petitioner. Furthermore, in case the petitioner finds any harassment, intimidation threat or duress at the hands of the private respondents, she shall inform the concerned SHO who shall look into the allegations, in case, the allegations make of the cognizable offence, shall immediately register an FIR.

Due to aforesaid observations, the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file afresh, in case of any further threat perception.
