The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 158 dated 08.11.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 341, 427, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner. He is only alleged to have pointed a pistol at the complainant. He also contends that the offence punishable under Section 307 IPC has been deleted, as the injury on the person of the injured, which has been attributed to co-accused, is on the arm and not life threatening.

This Court, by the order dated 04.12.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Naib Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 04.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
