The petition prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 238 dated 07.10.2020, registered under Sections 323, 382, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, Punjab.

The operative part of the order dated 26.11.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that main accused Harpreet Singh @ Preet was arrested and he has been granted concession of regular bail by the trial Court, vide order dated 27.10.2020 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that there is a delay of two days in registration of the FIR and the dispute is primarily of civil nature.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 26.11.2020, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbag Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 26.11.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
