1. Prayerin the writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to grant benefit to the petitioner of B-1 selection (Lower School Course) and Intermediate School Course as also promotion alongwith all consequential benefits with effect from the date the juniors of the petitioner/similarly situated persons have been granted the said benefit in view of judgment Annexure P-2 and Annexure P-3 dated 02.03.20215 and 26.11.2019 respectively.

2. At the outset, learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representation Annexure P-4 dated 06.03.2020 in respect of the claim which is the subject matter of the instant petition but no decision has been taken in respect thereto till date, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-4 dated 06.03.2020 in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.3 only.
4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and after perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
5. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties, gone over the paper book and in view of the position noted above as also statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, dispose of the instant petition by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-4 dated 06.03.2020, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter within 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
6. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
