The case was taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

CRM-M No.30369 of 2020

Prayer made in this application is for impleading the complainant Sanjeev Kumar Raheja as party/respondent No.2.

Notice of this application was issued to the non-applicant on 07.01.2021.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Complainant Sanjeev Kumar Raheja is ordered to arrayed as party/respondent No.2.

Main case

Petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.0125 dated 13.06.2020 registered under Sections 341, 406, 420, 506 IPC at Police Station Ismailabad District Kurukshetra and entire subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Vide order of even date, passed in CRM-M No.17926 of 2020 titled '*Nirmal Singh vs. State of Haryana*' filed by the petitioner himself for grant of anticipatory bail has been dismissed on merits. The case involves disputed question of facts which needs to be adjudicated by way of proper investigation and on the basis of evidence to be led by the parties during trial. Inherent jurisdiction of the High Court under Section 482 Cr.P.C. cannot be exercised in respect of disputed facts particularly in the nature of controversy involved in the present case.

This petition is found to be totally devoid of merits and is accordingly dismissed.
