The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.15 dated 29.10.2020, registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 IPC and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act at Police Station Women, Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Notice of motion was issued on 25.11.2020. The parties were directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Ferozepur on 21.12.2020. They were directed to adhere

to the medical protocol issued by the Ministry of Health, Government of India of COVID-19 pandemic. Arrest of the petitioners was stayed in the meanwhile.

Report of the Mediation and Conciliation Centre, Ferozepur has been received from where it can be deduced that the parties have amicably resolved their differences by way of entering into amicable resolution of dispute. The parties have compromised the matter on certain terms and conditions.

In view above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioners are directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 19.01.2021 and in the event of their arrest, they shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- i) that the petitioner(s) shall make himself available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- ii) that the petitioner(s) shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any

police officer;

- iii) that the petitioner(s) shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.
