1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ, order or direction for holding impugned order Annexure P/3 dated 14.09.2021, to be inoperative qua the petitioner.
3. Learned DAG, Punjab, on written instructions from the office of the Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh, contends that in compliance of order of this Court in CWP-4829-2011, joint seniority of C-I and C-II of Armed and District cadre was prepared w.e.f. 01.01.1975 to 20.02.2008, and was circulated vide office letter No.12108-12208/E-1 (5) dated 10.11.2017 as per which the petitioner was given revised date as Head Constable w.e.f. 23.06.2003 instead of 02.05.1999 and his name was entered at seniority No.17840 and further that as per the revised seniority of Head Constables, Head Constables

who were deputed for Intermediate School Course commencing from 01.03.2021 on completion of the course, were promoted to the rank of ASI w.e.f. 14.09.2021 and that the petitioner who was given revised date as Head Constable w.e.f. 23.06.2003 instead of 02.05.1999, was also promoted to the rank of ASI along with his batch-mates w.e.f. 14.09.2021. Copy of written instructions from the office of the Director General, Police are taken on record, copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Faced with the aforementioned stand, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the stand of learned DAG, Punjab as referred to above, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take out appropriate proceedings to seek redress of his grievances in accordance with law.

5. The same is not opposed to by the learned DAG, Punjab.

6. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for.
