GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

Today, at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to move an application for grant of regular bail. Learned counsel further submits that in fact his absence before the trial Court was on account of a wrong impression he carried as the matter had been compromised amongst the parties and a petition for quashing of the FIR had already been filed in this Court, which is still pending.

In view of the aforestated submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within 10 days from today and moves an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall consider the same sympathetically particularly keeping in view the fact that the matter is stated to be compromised amongst the parties. The trial Court shall endeavour to dispose of the regular bail application expeditiously and if the pleas

raised on behalf of the petitioner are found to be meritorious, the same may be disposed of on the day such application is filed, provided the same is conveniently possible.
