The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.209 dated 16.09.2020 under Sections 452, 336, 323, 324, 326, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC, 1860, and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 25.11.2020 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Amrit Pal Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 25.11.2020, is hereby made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
