Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to conduct a fair and impartial investigation by a Senior Police Officer on her complaint dated 17.10.2019 (Annexure P-1) and take necessary action against respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner was abused by the private respondents No.5 to 7 on 14.10.2019 and the same incident was repeated on 16.10.2019. He submits that despite her representation dated 17.10.2019 (Annexure P-1), no action has been taken.

A perusal of the communications dated 16.2.2020 and 24.2.2020 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) makes it clear that the representation was looked into, but no substance was found in it, therefore, the same was filed.

The petitioner has filed this petition after a long delay on 11.10.2021. Consequently, this Court is not inclined to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed.
