The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0043 dated 02.05.2019, under Sections 307, 452, 427, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has not been attributed any injury. It is alleged that the co-accused had taken pistol from the petitioner and fired a shot at the injured.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 22.08.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 22.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
