This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 4 dated 21.10.2020, under Section 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and Section 7, 13(1) (a) read with Section 13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (as amended by Prevention of Corruption Act, 2018), registered at Police Station Economic Offence Wing, Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 26.11.2020 granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.
