Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 694 dated 26.10.2020, registered under Sections 406/420 of the IPC at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The operative part of the order dated 26.11.2020, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in order to show his *bona fide*, the petitioner is ready to deposit an amount of Rs. 02 Lakh with the trial Court/Illaqua Magistrate within a period of two months from today, subject to final outcome of the case.

Notice of motion for 09.02.2021.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner

shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

However, this will be subject to a condition that petitioner will deposit an amount of Rs. 02 Lakh with trial Court/Illaqua Magistrate within a period of two months from today, which will be kept in an FDR, subject to final outcome of the case.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdial Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation. Learned State counsel, on instructions, further submits that petitioner has deposited the aforesaid amount of Rs. 2 Lakh with the Illaqua Magistrate. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the complainant.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 26.11.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
