This petition has been filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., for grant of 'regular bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 52, dated 01.04.2019, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Taran Taran, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 457/307/392/511/120-B/148/149 of the IPC.

An affidavit of the DSP Sub-Division Patti, dated 23.08.2021, has been filed in court today by learned counsel for the State, which is ordered to be taken on record.

As per the said affidavit, though the petitioner and his co-accused were alleged to have been armed with a '*Datar*', however, no injury was received by the complainant Kulwinder Kaur nor any of her family member; whereas on the other hand, the petitioners' companion Rahul and Paras received injuries, with Rahul having died due to those injuries, and a cross-version to the FIR registered.

In view of the aforesaid circumstances, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
