Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.225 dated 08.08.2019, under Sections 328, 341, 387, 506, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala Cantt.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the complainant had been befriended by the petitioner and other accused and later blackmailed by administering poisonous substance. The petitioner, who is a 30 year old lady, is in custody for over 01 year and 10 months since her arrest on 16.10.2019. He further contends that co-accused Veena @ Rajji has been granted regular bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-23665-2020 on 24.09.2020.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Balkar Singh states that 02 out of 23 prosecution witnesses have been examined. He also contends that the petitioner is involved in another case of similar nature wherein she along with co-accused had blackmailed the complainant therein.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner, who is a lady, is in custody for over 01 year and 10 months, co-accused has been granted bail, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
