The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.161 dated 08.05.2016, under Sections 148, 149, 302, 120-B IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Civil Lines Sonapat, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of the co-accused. It is alleged that the deceased had an evil eye on the mother of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody for over 4 years and 9 months since his arrest on 13.05.2016 and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel contends that only one prosecution witness remains to be examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 4 years and 9 months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time due to the COVID-19

pandemic, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petitioner shall appear before the police station Civil Lines Sonapat every alternate Monday till the conclusion of the trial.
