ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 397 dated 18.09.2021, under Sections 308, 323 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is alleged to have taken place at 11:00 a.m. on 17.09.2021 while the FIR was lodged on the next day at 08:30 p.m. The MLR was also conducted at 08.40 p.m. wherein the injuries were found to be simple in nature. The duration of the time with regard to the injuries has been opined as within ten hours. All the injuries are bruises except a lacerated wound on the forehead of approximately 3 cm. The petitioner is 52 years of age and is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court, by the order dated 13.10.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 13.10.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
