(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.135 dated 26.12.2019 registered under Sections 354-D, 384, 503, 509 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 66D, 67A and 67 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 at Police Station Daresi, Ludhiana.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to file application for grant of regular bail on surrender before the trial Court which application may be ordered to be disposed of expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Needless to say that on such surrender and filing of application for grant of regular bail by the petitioner, the trial Court shall dispose of the application for grant of regular bail expeditiously.
