The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to official respondent No.2 to protect the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.3, who is unnecessary harassing the petitioner at the behest of respondent No.4.

Counsel for the petitioner herein prays that the instant petition be treated as a representation of the petitioner and the same be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

At this stage, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG Punjab, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the

matter. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, it is ordered that the instant petition of the petitioner be treated as a representation of the petitioner, with a direction to the official respondents to decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
