The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.131, dated 16.09.2021, registered under Section 20 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

2. Seen Custody Certificate of the Petitioner, who has by now remained in detention for 1 month and 13 days.
3. The contraband allegedly recovered from the Petitioner was 7 kilograms of Ganja which is well below the commercial quantity.
4. There is no record of Petitioner's involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act, on account of which, this Court is of the opinion that he is not likely to commit a similar offence, if released on bail, at this stage.

5. In the circumstances, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the Petitioner, at this stage, for an indefinite period, is not called for. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate Concerned.
