LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

This is the petitioner's second petition for grant of bail pending trial in FIR No. 193, dated 11.10.2019 under Section 306 of IPC (Section 302 IPC added later on), Police Station, Sadar Patiala, District Patiala. The first bail petition was dismissed as withdrawn on 19.08.2020. However, it has been mentioned that the present petition is the first petition and there is a specific averment in para 15 of the petition that the petitioner has not filed such or similar petition either before this Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court and no other application is pending before any other Court at the time of filing of the present petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it is due to an inadvertent mistake and ignorance on the part of petitioner that such an averment has come to be made in the present petition. He seeks to withdraw this petition.

Though, I was inclined to impose cost on account of the conduct of the petitioner but at fervent request of learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that petitioner is an illiterate person and is in custody, refrain from doing so.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
