The petitioner is seeking regular bail in Rapat No.49 dated 13.05.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 34 IPC and Rapat No.37 dated 22.08.2019 vide which offence under Section 326 IPC was added in FIR No.79 dated 29.05.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is a case of version and cross-version. The petitioner himself had received several injuries in the occurrence. A copy of the MLR is at Annexure P-4. He also contends that the petitioner is in custody for almost 06 months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kuldip Singh, contends that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the above especially when it is a case of version and cross-version, the petitioner himself was injured, he is in custody for almost 06 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
