The petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-9) which is still pending with a further prayer to count the daily wage service of the petitioners for their retrial benefits as per Rules, along with certain other prayers.

The counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-9) served by the petitioners, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Rathee, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioners.

In view of the above, respondents are directed to take a conscious decision in the legal notice dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-9), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioners are found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents-State, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioners within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
