The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No.79 dated 26.05.2020 under Sections 323, 325, 336, 427, 148, 149 and 188 IPC as well as Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar, submits that in the aforesaid FIR, after conducting investigation, the police has prepared a cancellation report and the same has been presented to the Court on 03.02.2021. In this manner, nothing survives in the present petition.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 7 days notice shall be served upon him.
