[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representation (Annexure P-2) dated 09.08.2021 to respondent Nos.2 & 3 but no decision has been taken on the same and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-2) dated 09.08.2021 and take action in respect thereto, in accordance with law and to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner.

[3] Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.

[4] Mr. Amit Mehta, learned Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and on perusal of the petition states that in the facts and circumstances of the case, he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

[5] Accordingly, in the light of statements of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-2) dated 09.08.2021, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 02 weeks from today and take appropriate action in respect thereto, if any, warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case.
