The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for directing the official respondents to conduct inquiry against respondent No.7 who misappropriated/embezzled the sweat earned money of petitioners under Mahatma Gandhi National Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 (MNREGA) and to seize the powers of Sarpanch on account of irregularity and misappropriation/embezzlement caused to the

villagers and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents and to decide the representations Annexures P-1 to P-5.
