Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439
Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR
No. 60 dated 13.04.2019 registered under Sections 307, 308, 324,
325, 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC at Police Station City-I,
Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Earlier a bail petition filed by the petitioner i.e.,
CRM-M-42421-2019, (titled '*Balkar Singh vs. State of Punjab*')
was dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated 15.09.2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at the most the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the right thigh of the injured-Raffi Kumar with *rod* and in this manner the injury was on the non-vital part of the body of the complainant. The petitioner is stated to be in custody for about one year and nine months and no other case is pending against him.

The injured has been summoned by the Court but he has not come forward to depose so far.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the custody and injury attributed by the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Noticing the fact that the petitioner is in custody for about one year and nine months and the injury attributed to the petitioner is on the right thigh of the injured-Raffi Kumar with blunt weapon (rod) on non vital part of body of injured and no other case is pending against him, this Court deems it appropriate to admit the petitioner on bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly.
