Petitioner herein, *inter alia*, seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider her case for promotion from the post of Anganwadi Helper to Anganwadi worker.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was appointed in the year, 2006 as Anganwadi Helper and the candidates, who were appointed much later than her in the year- 2007, have been promoted as Anganwadi Worker but the case of the petitioner has not been considered. He further submits that qua her aforesaid grievance, petitioner submitted a representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-6), but to no avail. Hence, the instant petition.

3. Learned State counsel, on advance service, joins proceedings and states that the competent authority shall take appropriate decision on the pending representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-6).

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner also agrees that let a final decision is taken, either way, by the competent authority on the

pending representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-6), giving reasons thereof.

5. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to look into the grievance of the petitioner as per representation dated 15.07.2020 (Annexure P-6) and also by keeping in view the contention raised in the present petition by treating the same as supplementary representation and take a decision, in accordance with law.

7. Let the needful be done by passing a speaking order within a period of 03 months from today. If a favorable order is passed, benefit thereof be accorded within 30 days thereafter.

8. Disposed of accordingly.
