The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the demand of ₹25,53,000/- as stamp duty paid by the petitioner under the compulsion and under protest at the time of registration of sale deed by HSIIDC dated 17.04.2017 in respect of plot No.311, Phase-II, Udhyog Vihar, Dundahera, Gurgaon; along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 05.05.2017 (Annexure P-16), within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has submitted that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondents-State is directed to take a conscious decision upon the representation dated 05.05.2017 (Annexure P-16) served by the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioner is found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents-State, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioner within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
