HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect lives and personal liberty of petitioners which they allege is in danger at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 16.

It is stated that both petitioners are major and they had solemnized marriage on 3.6.2020 against wishes of family members and relatives of petitioner No. 1 who are arrayed as respondents No. 4 to 16 in this petition. Petitioners have earlier filed CRWP-3492-2020 which was disposed of vide order dated 8.6.2020 with directions to official respondents to look into representation and take appropriate action in accordance with law. Alleging that despite said directions, petitioners continued to be threatened by private respondents, present petition has been filed.

Reply by way of affidavit of Saurabh Chander, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ, Fatehabad (Haryana) on behalf of respondents has been filed wherein it has been stated that on 12.12.2020, statements of respondents No. 4 to 16 were recorded. In the statement of respondent No. 4 Kulwant Singh, father of petitioner No. 1 has stated that he has no objection to the marriage of petitioner No. 1 with petitioner No. 2. Similarly, statements of respondents No. 5 and 7 were recorded on same date. They also stated that they have no objection to the marriage of petitioners. Copies of their statements have been annexed with reply. It is further stated that in case, any complaint or representation from petitioners is received at any time in future, effective action will be taken in accordance with law.
