JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0224 dated 20.10.2019 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 406 & 34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from her.

Learned A.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from ASI Raj Virender Pal Singh submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 27.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
